And I finally received it in the name of the Prophet JEREMIAH, whom I have loved since I was a small child for his lamentation over Jerusalem which crucified and crucifies our Christ.

During this whole time, even though I was in my parents' care in San Francisco, close to Archbishop Kyril of San Francisco and his Vicar Bishop Theodosios, serving them as a celebrant in the Cathedral of the Theotokos "Joy of All Who Sorrow" and catechist of the youth in the church school there of Saints Cyril and Methodius, always under the vigilant care and maternal concern of Abbess Aemiliane of the Monastery of the Entrance of the Theotokos under your Holy Omophore in Maryland, I felt and I feel the incurable longing to return to Petra permanently, anticipating your Release Letter to the Monastery of Petra, where I was tonsured and from where I was canonically sent to the land of which I am an American citizen.
